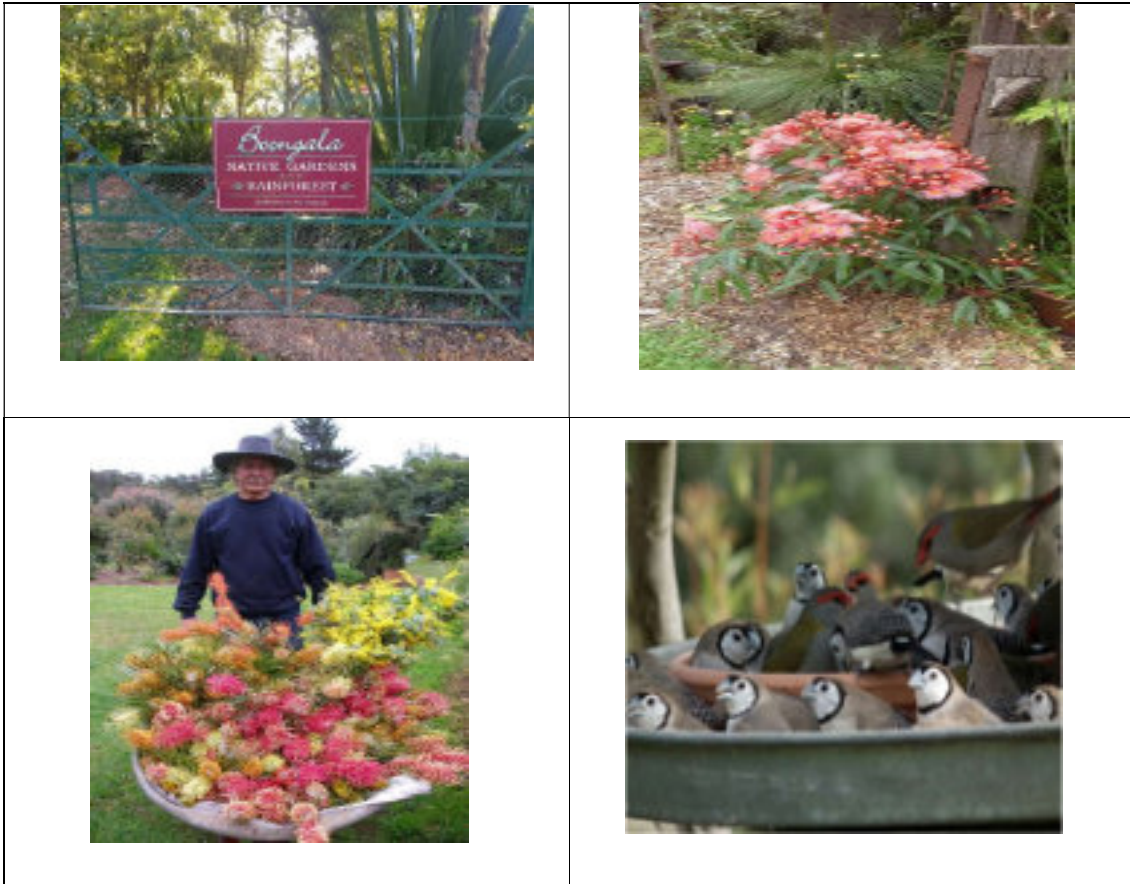


Boongala Native Gardens and
